## PAPER

Cardboard & boxboard  
Food & beverage cartons  
Magazines & newspaper inserts  
Newspapers  
Pizza boxes (with no grease stains/food)

Gift bags  
Paper Cups (hot or cold)  
Take-out containers  
Paper towels, napkins, tissues  
Shredded paper  
Tissue Paper

## GLASS

Beverage bottles & jars ★  
Food bottles & jars ★

Ceramic mugs & plates  
Drinking glasses  
Windows & mirrors

## METAL

Aluminum foil  
Cans & bottles  
Foil containers  
Metal lids from cans & bottles  
Aerosol containers (food grade only)

Aerosol containers (cleaners, pesticides, etc)  
Foil tops from yogurt containers  
Paint cans  
Pots & pans  
Small pieces of scrap metal  
Spiral wound containers

## PLASTIC

Plastic bottles (with or without caps attached)  
Plastic containers, tubs & lids  
Plastic one-use cups (no lids, no straws)

Black plastic pots & containers  
Loose bottle caps  
Single-use coffee containers  
Styrofoam cups & containers  
Water filters  
Plastic plates, bowls & utensils  
Prescription bottles  
Plastic wrap & bags ★

★ Acceptable plastic bags & wraps can be recycled at participating stores
